

A Voyage Along the Great Lakes

In alliance with Smithsonian Journeys, this 8-day cruise among the Great Lakes will take you from the cosmopolitan city of Toronto in Canada's Ontario province, to Wisconsin's Milwaukee, famous for its breweries. Sail the canal connecting Lake Ontario and Lake Eerie, and observe the impressive Niagara Falls, one of the world's true natural wonders. On Lake Huron, you'll observe myriad islands amid a kaleidoscope of color: white rocks, capped with green conifers plunging into the sapphire waters of the lake. You'll also visit the UNESCO Biosphere Reserve of Georgian Bay, the largest freshwater archipelago in the world, and traverse the Soo Locks as you head into Lake Superior, ending your journey by sailing the length of Lake Michigan, a veritable inland sea.
